The Sovereignty of God

Psalm 139:16 – Your eyes have seen my unformed substance; And in your book were written the days that were ordained for me, when as yet there was not one of them.

Genesis 50:20 – As for you, you meant evil against me, but God meant it for good to bring about this present result, to preserve many people alive.

Ecclesiastes 7:13 – Consider the work of God, For who is able to straighten what He has bent?

John 3:16 – For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

Luke 22:31 - 32: “Simon, Simon, behold, Satan has demanded to permission to sift you like wheat; ³² but I have prayed for you, that your faith may not fail; and you, when once you have turned again, strengthen your brothers.”

2Corinthians 10:3 – For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh

2Corinthians 10:4 – for the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses.

2Corinthians 11:14 – No wonder, for even Satan disguises himself as an angel of light

Ephesians 6:12 – For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against spiritual forces of wickedness in heavenly places.

James 4:7 – So, submit to God, but resist the devil and he will flee from you

Jude 1:9 – When Michael the archangel disputed with the devil and argued about the body of Moses, he did dare pronounce a railing judgment against him, but said, “The Lord rebuke you!”

Zechariah 3:1 – Then he showed me Joshua the high priest standing before the angel of the Lord and Satan standing at his right hand to accuse him.

Matthew 16:23 – But He turned to Peter and said, “Get behind Me, Satan! You are a stumbling block to me, for you are setting your mind on God’s interests, but man’s.”

Luke 17:32 – Remember Lot’s wife

Romans 12:2 – And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good, and acceptable and perfect.

James 4:8 – Draw near to God and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners and make your hearts pure, you double-minded.

Psalms 119:11 – Thy word I have treasured in my heart that I would not sin against You.

1 John 2:28 – Now little children, abide in Him, so that when He appears, we may have confidence and not shrink away from Him in shame at His coming.
